

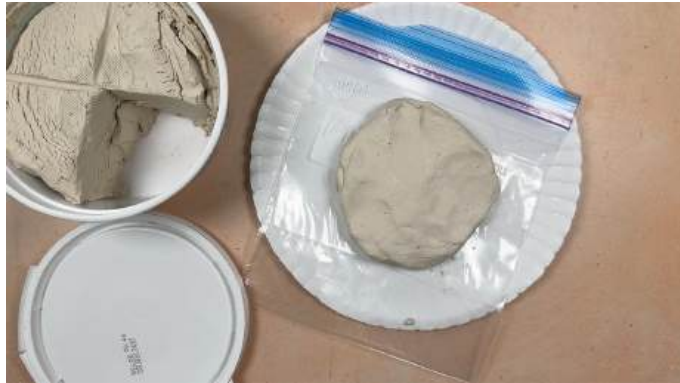
Air Dry Clay Sea Star



1. Supplies: Airdry clay, plate, plastic knife, chopstick



2. Cut a quarter of a 2.5 tub of clay for each star.



3. Soften with water and make a round disc.



4. Draw a star with the chopstick, or trace a template.



5. Cut out the star, lopsided legs are ok. Pick up the star and round the edges. Trim longer legs so they are all the same length.



6. Use a chopstick or similar tool to press and make a texture on the surface. Let dry for several days, or until the clay turns white.
