


Draw the Great Seal of the United States




1. Start with the shield. It does have 13 stripes, but just draw as many as you can.




2. Draw the top of the eagle head on top.




3. Add wings on the side. Try to make them symmetrical.




4. Draw the tail and two legs with claws.




5. Add arrows in the right foot. The official seal has 13, but just do your best.

8. Finish with a long ribbon that says "E PLURIBUS" and "UNUM".



9. Trace your drawing with a marker and color as shown.
