
1. Draw a large chain shape going off the top of the page.



4. Erase the gray lines. Draw part of a broken chain on the bottom.




7. Trace the letters so they have a dark pencil edge too.







8. Fill in all the letters and chain with an even shade of gray pencil color.







6. Draw another chain behind the side view one.
