Make an Air Dry Clay Cupcake



1. Gather your supplies of: Silicone cupcake holders, air dry clay, glossy acrylic paint in your colors of choice, brush and water.



2. Make two balls from the clay, about this size of a golf ball. Rub with a small amount of water to make it soft and sticky.



3. Press one ball into the silicone cup to form a thick little bowl.



4. Take the other ball, press your thumb inside, and form a small pinch pot for the top.



5. Soften and wet a little more clay to make a cherry. Press and wiggle to make sure it is securely attached.



6. Let dry for 2 to 3 days, or in the sun until clay turns white and feels like a stone.



7. Paint with acrylic paint. Add an extra coat to protect against chipping.



Optional: For extra protection, spray with clear sealer.
