

Dandelion Painting

Use rubber cement to block out some very pretty dandelions




MATERIALS NEEDED: Spectra® Tissue paper, Watercolor Paper, Rubber Cement, Paint B rush, black Sharpie marker, Premium Sulphite Heavyweight Jet Black Construction Paper


1. Use the bottom of a jar of rubber cement to draw three circles in pencil on watercolor paper. Add stems.




3. Cut squares of bleeding tissue paper. Apply with brush and water to drawing. Let tissue dry on the paper for about 10 minutes.



2. Draw dandelion stems and trace with a thin Sharpie marker. Erase the pencil lines. Cover each flower with a circle of rubber cement. Let dry for about 5 minutes or until dry to the touch.



4. Remove wet tissue paper squares. Let painting dry completely.



5. Rub any remaining rubber cement off with fingertips.
